



Declaration of the National Research Council of Thailand

Subject: Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Gifts or Gratuities from Performing Duties  
(No Gift Policy)

Fiscal Year B.E. 2567 (2024)

---

The National Research Council of Thailand (NRCT) is tasked with the authority and responsibility for funding research and innovation ; creating national database and indexes in sciences, research and innovation; initiating, driving and operating national key research and innovation projects; establishing research standards and ethics, to promote and transfer knowledge for application; supporting and encourage personnel development in terms of research and innovation; and giving awards, honor, or compliment individuals or institutions for their contributions to research and innovation.

As the government has prioritized and established policies and campaigns to combat corruption in all forms, the NRCT recognizes the significance and has policies that align with the government's direction. In order to demonstrate its commitment to transparency, good governance, and the creation of a positive culture, the NRCT has implemented a policy and issued a declaration that all NRCT executives and officials will not accept any gifts or gratuities of any kind in connection with their duties, adhering to the “No Gift Policy”. Therefore, executives and directors at all levels are expected to set a good example for the public and to supervise their subordinates to ensure that they behave correctly and strictly, except for items intended for public relations purposes related to the organization's activities, as appropriate and in line with the occasions.
